The ALS United community makes care services, research and advocacy possible through critical fundraising. Each year, Walk ALS is a celebration of the passion, generosity and fundraising led by this community. Follow these steps to help reach your 2025 fundraising goal. Mobile makes it easier than ever!!

Fundraising Tips



Register online and receive a unique fundraising page. Your page is where you'll share your goal and receive online donations. You'l also have access to mobile-friendly fundraising tools and templates.



Next update your fundraising page with an image and story about why you are fundraising. Your story is the most compelling.



Be the first gift. Start your fundraising with a self-donation. When others see your personal commitment, they're more likely to



It's time to spread the word. Begin by sharing your page link with your closest circle - texting is the best way to ensure your message is seen. Share that they're the first people you're asking for support. Then cast a wider net by sharing the page link on your social accounts and via emails.



Days are busy and messages can get buried. It can take 3+ reminders for someone to donate - even when they have the best intentions! So, don't be shy about sending reminder texts, posts and emails.



Every dollar you raise matters. Your fundraising page thermometer will show your progress to goal. Cash and check donations will be applied to your goal when submitted to the ALS United office.



Team Captain Checklist

Get started: (3-4 months before Walk)

- □ Name your team something meaningful, inspiring, fun, or all three!
- Set your team goals.
 Create your team and register yourself as the
- team captain.
- Customize your team page.
- □ Brainstorm who you want to recruit.
 □ Practice your recruitment script,
- especially "why we walk."

 Invite everyone on your list to join your
- team or support your efforts with a donation.
- ☐ Make sure all team members register.
 ☐ Have a kick-off call or meeting, especially.
- if you're a corporate team.

 Check your company's matching gift
- policy.

 Leverage the prewritten templates to
- send emails to everyone you know asking them to join your team and make a donation.
- Place articles in your company newsletters or website to recruit team members.
- Email your team weekly with fundraising updates and be sure to highlight new team members with a hearty welcome.
