



DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT DONATION APPRAISAL INFORMATION

PLEASE CONSULT YOUR ACCOUNTANT FOR ANY TAX ADVICE

- 1) If you choose to have your donated equipment appraised for tax purposes, you may need to have few pictures of the item being donated and the original invoice to show to the appraiser.
- 2) Please tell the appraiser that you are donating the equipment as a charitable contribution.
- 3) You would also need to complete IRS Form 8283 (attached), Section B, and the "Appraisal Summary Form." It must be signed by the appraiser. After it is signed by the appraiser, we will need to sign Part IV of Section B of that form as well.
- 4) Once you have the equipment appraised, we will verify that the donated equipment has been picked up and will then sign Part IV of the IRS form and return a copy to you for your taxes.
